## About Providence University

In answering to the recent national south bound policy of Taiwan, we're reaching out to the institution in Thailand and intensify the collaboration. It is our sincere hope that Providence University could host the short-term study in Taiwan for students from Thailand.

Providence University is a Catholic co-educational institution that was founded in 1956 by an American congregation: the Sisters of Providence of Saint Mary-of-the-Woods, Indiana, USA. It is currently sponsored by the Catholic Diocese of Taichung. Providence University is one of the prominent educational institutions in Taiwan, with 22 departments, 19 graduate programs, two Ph.D. programs, 5 EMBA programs, and one Chinese Language Education Center. We currently have approximate 12,000 undergraduate students, 1,200 postgraduate students and 400 full-time faculties. PU offers fully taught English program in International Business Administration (BIBA) as well as Graduate International Program (MBA). Furthermore, PU provides programs and courses which are taught in English in the field of Science and information Science.

## Goals of the Program

- (1) Through the short-term cultural program and practical experience PU may present, we hope that Thai students will gain more attention and interest about Taiwan by introducing them the most attractive sightseeing places and various foods around Taiwan.
