

**Qualifications and Selection of Faculty Adviser for International Students in the  
Master's Program of the College of Management at Providence University**

Approved at the College Affairs Meeting on Oct. 13, 2010

Article 1 This shall apply to international students studying for a master's degree of the College of Management (hereinafter referred to as the college).

Article 2 Faculty adviser should possess one of the following qualifications:

- (1) Has served as professor or associate professor;
- (2) Has served as academician, research fellow or associate research fellow at the Academia Sinica;
- (3) Holds a Ph.D. degree, with outstanding academic achievements;
- (4) Has achieved academic or professional expertise, in the case of rare or special disciplines. This applies to the first three types; for the fourth type, qualifications of the faculty adviser should be confirmed by relevant regulations governing faculty members with said degree.

Article 3 Each faculty member may serve as adviser to a maximum of three students.

Article 4 If the faculty adviser is an inter-university (inter-collegiate) faculty member, he or she should be joined by at least a full-time assistant professor of the college or of the degree program who will serve as co-adviser; faculty adviser quota shall be calculated at 0.5.

Article 5 Deadline for adviser application is six months prior to the oral defense application; no extension shall be granted.

Article 6 After completion of the application procedure, should the adviser be unable to continue on with the work, the student should re-apply. The student should again apply for the oral defense six months after the reapplication process.

Article 7 Should the advisee take a break from the program, he or she may apply for a new adviser upon return to the university. A change in adviser shall be incorporated into the annual budget of the school year in which the advisee returns.

Article 8 This selection process shall be implemented after being approved at the college affairs meeting of the College of Management; the same shall apply to all amendments.
