

Providence University Connects with the World

One of the most significant goals of Providence University is to make its students become globally competitive. For this reason, PU has recently adopted a new way to make it easier for the disadvantaged students to also have the opportunity to study abroad. After all, PU has received the largest financial support from the Ministry of Education with its good reputation of helping students be more internationalized. The most recent one is 64 million scholarship for disadvantaged students.

Cheers (a magazine) published in February, states that they interview International students as well as those students from Taiwan and China. With regard to the standard of International exchanging power, PU is on top compared to other private universities in Taiwan and no. 5 for sending students abroad.

PU not only pushes the concept of international campus which includes 411 exchange program but also lets students go abroad during their vacation (summer and winter) and be exchange students while they are in the university.

Students who cannot study abroad can also attract foreign students to come to PU to study. The new assessment process has recently been implemented and recruited 346 students to study in PU through this scheme. Students only need to be in the first 50% of their study performance in high school. They can apply to enter PU with their grade in college entrance examination. As the percentage of different subjects is not the same, students can apply to the department according to their preference and interest.
